The Komera Junior Board of Directors provides an opportunity for highly-motivated, globally-inspired young professionals to serve as ambassadors of Komera and use their passion, dedication and skillset to advance our work. Junior Board members invest their time and talents to amplify the mission of Komera and lead specific Junior Board fundraising initiatives and events.

Your seat on the Komera Junior Board will provide an opportunity to learn about board governance, program management, budgeting, fundraising, and gain insight on day-to-day management of a nonprofit organization. During your time on the board, you will socialize with the Board of Directors, meet mentors and advisors, and build relationships with fellow Junior Board members with a shared passion for the cause.

Junior Board members will be invited and encouraged to join the Board of Directors on their annual summer trip to Rwanda to experience the transformational programs at Komera first-hand, and spend time with Komera students learning about our community.

While the Junior Board may provide support and advice to the Board of Directors, the Junior Board has no fiduciary responsibility or official governing power.

#### Commitment & Responsibilities:

- Two-year commitment to serve on the Junior Board
- Attend quarterly Junior Board meetings led by Komera leadership including a member of the Komera Board of Directors and Komera staff
- Potential opportunity to sit in on a Komera Board of Directors meeting
- Encouraged to participate in the planning and hosting of annual fundraising events
- Financial commitment to raise \$750 annually for Komera

As young philanthropists, Junior Board members are asked to raise a minimum of \$750 to support Komera during their annual term on the Board. Junior Board members are encouraged to work together with other members to plan and host their own events. Throughout the year, Komera hosts various annual events, such as cocktails, socials, and runs, that Junior Board members are welcome to use as fundraising opportunities and serve on the host committees for. Funds can be raised individually or by seeking sponsorships, corporate contributions, event ticket sales, or campaign donations to Komera. Komera will provide a platform for fundraising and tracking individual commitments.
